Dennis Moore Memorial Scholarship Fund

A. Introduction

The Revd. Dennis Moore was a well-known figure on the West Coast. He was ordained into the ministry of the Presbyterian Church in 1959 and served in the parishes of Ross South Westland. Retirement provided Dennis with continuing opportunities for service. Throughout his life and ministry Dennis constantly evidenced a keen interest in people and especially a concern for young people in need.

When he died in 1999, Dennis left a substantial bequest to Presbyterian Support. After discussion with Dennis' family, Presbyterian Support believed it appropriate to set aside \$10,000 per annum of Dennis' bequest to form a permanent legacy to his commitment to young people on the West Coast.

Following consultation with the Union parishes on the West Coast and the Moore family, Presbyterian Support has decided to establish a scholarship fund to enable West Coast young people to further their education, promote life skills programmes in schools and provide for the training of youth leaders/teachers.

B. The Fund

The Fund has been instituted primarily to assist a number of permanent West Coast residents to undertake secondary or tertiary education outside the West Coast region and to assist in the provision of educational programmes for young people and training of leaders for them.

The selection process will favour applicants who are most likely to be successful in their studies and those who are from financially disadvantaged backgrounds.

C. Method of Selection

The Awards Committee will base its recommendations for an academic scholarship on details from applicants' enrolment forms, personal interviews and additional information and references.

In order to be considered for an academic scholarship you must complete the attached Additional Information form, and return it to the Board Secretary, Presbyterian Support (Upper South Island) by Friday 6th November 2015. Any applicant who fails to complete and return this form by the due date cannot be considered for an award.

You should complete each section of the attached form carefully in the space provided. Please return this form only; **DO NOT** send curriculum vitae, certificates, references or any other supporting documentation.
